



Students - Getting Started with MathXL

MathXL is an interactive website where you can:

- Self-test to improve your math skills
- Complete exercises to help with specific textbook sections
- View a video for further understanding
- Create your own customized study plan

What do you need to get started?

- Valid e-mail address
- Student Access Code

What steps do I take next?

- 1) A MathXL Student Access Kit came packaged with your student textbook. Please open it and look within the inside front cover for this Student Access Code:



- 2) Go to www.mathxl.com and click the Register button. Enter your six-word access code found on the inside cover of your Student Access Kit (see step 1). This code is found under the yellow tab that reads "Student Access Code". Register only ONCE using the information above. You will create your own Login Name and Password.
- 3) Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the registration process. Note: When prompted for a zip code, please be sure to use the zip code for your school **32504** and NOT your personal zip code.

How do I log in and access my course?

- 1) Go to www.mathxl.com and enter the Login Name and Password you created during registration.
- 2) Select your school from the School menu. **Select Pensacola Junior College.**
- 3) Select your **instructor's name** and the **name of your course** from the Instructor/Course menu.

TIP: If your school and instructor are not listed, your instructor has not set up a course for you in MathXL. You can still study on your own by choosing your textbook from the book list and clicking Submit. You can use pre-loaded sample tests to generate a study plan and work through practice exercises to master the topics in your textbook.

- 4) Click the Submit button and follow the on-screen instructions to [run the Installation Wizard](#) for your course.
